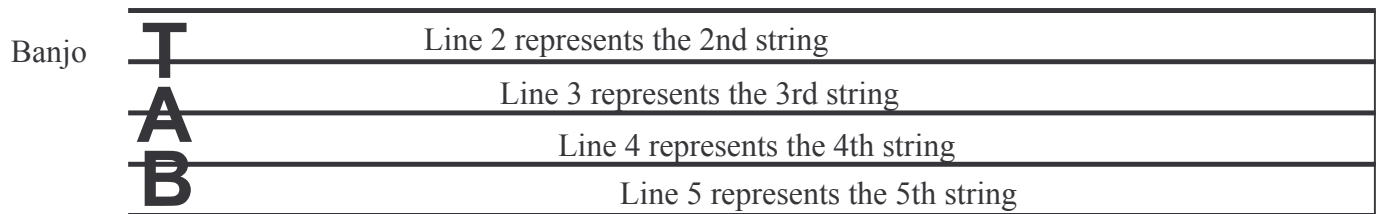


# Banjo Tablature

This top line or line 1 represents the 1st string or the bottom string as you hold the banjo



Line 5 is the top string on your banjo as you hold the banjo and look down at the strings. It is the skinny string at the top and has it's own tuning knob off to the side of the banjo neck.

The numbers located on the lines which represent the strings of the banjo tell you which fret to play. For example, the 4 below, tells you to press down on the 4th fret and play string #1. In other words: 4th fret - 1st string.
